## Dos and Don'ts

Do - Move your vehicle and/or avoid areas where the Public Works crew is clearing snow.

Don't - Follow snow clearing equipment closely and/or speed past them as they are working.



Do - Inform the Town of Provost when you notice a plugged or frozen-over storm drain.

Don't - Add more snow to the street, making it difficult for melting snow to flow into the storm drain.

Do - Clear off your sidewalks within 24 hours of the current snowfall; use sand/salt mix supplied at the Public Works Shop.

Don't - Leave your sidewalk full of snow & ice. You are making it easier for people to slip and fall and cause injury.



Do - Ensure your extension cord is secured in some way to the sidewalk or hang the cord from a tree.

Don't - Place your cord on the sidewalk to cause a tripping hazard.

Do - Set out your garbage and/or compost bin on the front curb by 7 am on collection day.

Don't - Set out your garbage and/or compost bin on the front curb after the truck has gone by and call the office that the driver missed it. Their vehicles have GPS. The company knows when the truck stops to do pickups.

Do - Remove your garbage and/or compost bin from the curb by the end of the collection day.

Don't - Leave the bin on the street any longer than 48 hours after collection. If it is damaged or gone missing, you will be charged for a replacement bin.

Do - License your dog(s) and/or cat(s).

Don't - Let your animal run free without being licensed. The fines and the cost of the license are to be paid before you get your pet returned to you.



Do - Respect other people by not making any extremely loud noise between the hours of 10 pm and 7 am.

Don't - Park your vehicle on the street longer than 72 hours (3 days), left of center; and/or on the street or roadway where it interferes with traffic.
